

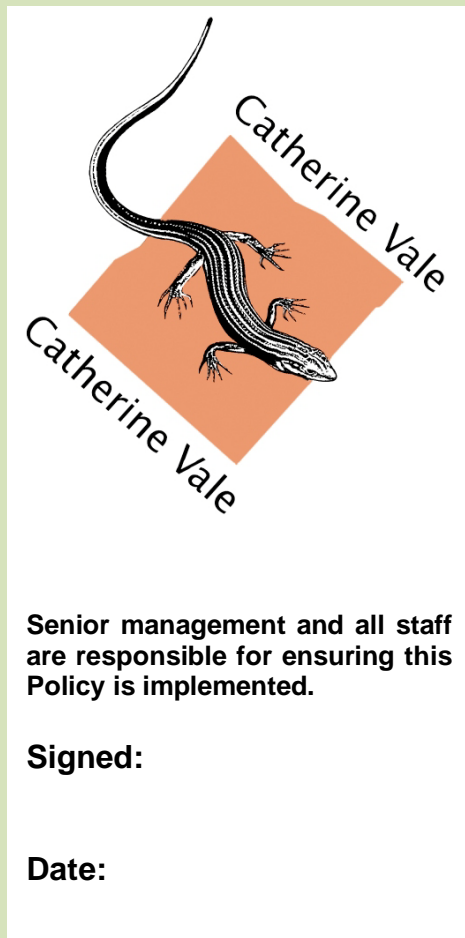
Our Environmental Policy

Catherine Vale Vineyard is a 10 acre (4.5ha) vineyard on a 100 acre property (40.52ha) located in the Broke Fordwich Wine Region of the Hunter Valley with within the Singleton Local Government area of NSW. The remaining portion of the property includes 25 ha of virgin bushland with native vegetation bordering on Yengo National Park. A fire trail runs through the property to assist with fire management. The property has 3 dams. One dam is for irrigation purposes and the other 2 are for possible cattle and provides native wildlife with water and assists with possible excessive run off. We endeavour to provide best management practices in all aspects of running the property and are committed to proactively managing our interaction with the environment by establishing standards of environmental excellence.



To achieve this we will:

- Incorporate environmental responsibilities and accountabilities into every aspect of our operations.
- Ensure all casual and seasonal staff are aware of our environmental policies.
- Inform all companies involved with the delivery of fuels and chemicals and vineyard supplies are aware of our environmental Policy and encourage them to respect our policy.
